PATTERN OF THE ASSESSMENT

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

I. Attendance and Punctuality

1. The school day begins with assembly at 9.05 a.m. Students must report by 9.00 a.m.
2. A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory for all students.
3. Latecomers must get their late-coming record signed by the class teacher before entering class.
4. Leave must be supported by a written application; for unplanned leave, a note countersigned by the Principal is required upon return.
5. Leave due to illness must be communicated within five days with a doctor's certificate and a parent/guardian's note.
6. Students recovering from contagious illnesses must remain at home and inform the Principal before returning.



II. Permissions and Campus Protocol

7. Students may not leave the campus during school hours without written permission from the Principal and Class Teacher, and must be accompanied by a parent or an authorized guardian.
8. No student will be sent with unauthorized individuals unless a written note from parents/guardians is provided.
9. Visitors and personal calls are not permitted for students during school hours. Urgent messages will be relayed through the office.
10. Parents and guardians are not allowed to visit their children during class time.

III. Discipline and Conduct

11. English must be spoken at all times within the school premises and school bus.
12. Students are not allowed to change classrooms or seats without the teacher's permission.
13. Playing in classrooms and corridors is strictly prohibited; silence must be observed during class hours.
14. Scribbling or damaging walls, furniture, or property is forbidden.
15. Damage to school property must be reported and repaired or replaced by the student.
16. Students must maintain high moral standards, good manners, and respectful behaviour.
17. Serious violations will lead to suspension, at the Principal's discretion.

IV. Uniform and Personal Appearance

18. Wearing the prescribed school uniform is compulsory on all working days.
19. Students may wear casual dress only on their birthdays.



20. Boys must have neat, non-fancy haircuts. Girls must tie their hair with black bands; long hair should be made into Pony Tail.
21. Shoes must be polished daily. Nails must be trimmed and kept short. Nail polish is strictly prohibited.
22. Students not in uniform will not be allowed in class or on the school premises on regular working days.

V. Food

23. Lunch is provided from the common mess for students from Pre-KG to XII.
24. Breakfast is provided for students from Pre-KG to UKG.
25. Mess fees are not calculated on a daily basis; it is a fixed charge.

VI. Communication and Responsibilities

26. Parents must inform the school of any change in address or contact number immediately.
27. Teachers should be contacted only during designated hours, as shared by the teacher.
28. Homework and test modules must be completed and submitted on time. Parents must countersign test modules.

VII. Examinations and Academic Integrity

29. No retests will be provided for missed examinations.
30. Attendance for all school functions and events is compulsory.

VIII. Prohibited Items and Activities

31. Mobile phones are not allowed as per government regulations.
32. Students are not permitted to bring non-school reading material (books, newspapers, periodicals) without Principal's permission.
33. Gifts to Teachers are not allowed unless permitted by the Principal.



IX. Health and Medical Care

- 34. For non-emergency medical needs, the school will notify the parents, and they must take the child to the hospital.
- 35. Students suffering from serious illness must recover fully before returning to school.

X. Special Contributions and Birthdays

- 36. Students may sponsor books or plant saplings on their birthdays as a contribution to the school.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

1. Students are generally expected to avail the school transport. Students who are willing to take the bus service, must, as a rule, continue to use the service throughout the year.
2. The school will not provide alternative transport facilities to students who miss the bus. While waiting for the school bus, students should be alert and show exemplary behaviour. Playing at these centres is strictly forbidden.
3. At the bus stop, students shall get into the bus in an orderly manner. As a safety measure, they should not put their hand or head outside the window. Inside the bus, students should not fight with each other and run around from one seat to another.
4. Children should be alert and maintain discipline in the bus.
5. After getting down from the bus, children should wait at the bus stop, till the bus moves. They should be very cautious and see that they cross the road only after the bus has left the stop.
6. Students who cause any damage to the bus will have to pay the penalty, that will be fixed by the principal based on the report from the crew.
7. The school reserves the right to deny the use of the school transport to any student at any time, to change the route or to cancel any particular route, if deemed necessary.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS

1. Parents are especially requested to read the rules carefully and see that they are followed by their wards.
2. The school authorities rely upon the full co-operation of the parents and guardians in all matters concerning the education of their children.
3. Remarks made in the diary by the Principal or the Teacher should be acknowledged and signed.



4. It is not recommended to take your child for family and social functions on school days, as it disrupts the learning process. Consistent cooperation between parents and school authorities ensures the success of the child.
5. Any form of criticism of a teacher or the school in front of students should be strictly avoided. In case of such circumstance(s), the student loses the respect for his/her teacher and fails to learn from him/her. If you have a genuine problem or complaint, you may approach the principal.
